I am writing you today at the suggestion of the Susquehanna Township Police Department.

For several years now, you and your colleagues have been aggressively promoting your political agenda on property tax reform. You have attempted to intimidate Senator Teplitz and his staff on a number of occasions.

I understand that proponents of issues are often emotionally invested and can, at times, cross the line between advocacy and criminal behavior.

Twice this week, including the morning of August 27, 2016, you and your colleagues crossed that line by trespassing at Senator Teplitz' home and his neighbor's home, disturbing the neighborhood, and causing fear to the families involved, including small children.

Let me be crystal clear with you, however, that your attempts to intimidate Senator Teplitz' family are not only counterproductive, but also subject you and your members to potential legal liability.


Please be advised that you and your colleagues are no longer welcome in his offices, events, or any place where he or his staff are doing business. Furthermore, you are not welcome at his home or in his neighborhood. Any communication you need to have with Senator Teplitz should be done in writing to his Capitol office via the U.S. Mail and he will respond accordingly.

I hope I do not need to inform you that any further intimidation by you or your colleagues will be treated as criminal behavior and handled accordingly. In the meantime, you are directed

to remove any and all photos that you have posted to social media of Senator Teplitz' or his neighbors' homes.

For your information, Senate Security, Capitol Police, and the Susquehanna Township Police have all been apprised of the situation.
